Any donation to the Society made at the time of purchase of Interment Rights is not refundable.

5. The amount deposited to the Care and Maintenance Fund maintained pursuant to The Cemeteries Act (Revised): 40% of the sale price of the lot or \$150.00 whichever is greater.

6. No marker or headstone may be installed unless and until the Society shall have issued a permit.

7. No marker or headstone may be installed unless and until the Society shall have received the amount required to be deposited into the Care and Maintenance Fund for installation of a marker as determined pursuant to the regulations made under The Cemeteries Act (Revised). Current charges are: for an upright marker 4' or less in height and 4' or less in length including the base, the sum of \$100.00. As well the Society must have received payment of the foundation on which the headstone is situate, currently \$300.00 for a single headstone and \$600.00 for a double headstone.

RESTRICTIONS

This Certificate cannot be transferred. In the event that the Interment Rights are not used by the Rights Holder named above, he or she or his or her personal representative shall be entitled to a refund of the amount paid, less permitted deductions, in accordance with The Cemeteries Act (Revised). In the event that

any transfer of Interment Rights may be permitted, this Certificate must be returned to the Chenstochover Aid Society which will issue a new Certificate to the Transferee.

The interment rights represented by this Certificate terminate on the Rights Holder named above ceasing to be a member in good standing of Chenstochover Aid Society. The Rights Holder shall be entitled in such event to a refund of the amount paid as Reservation Fee, less permitted deductions, in accordance with The Cemeteries Act (Revised).

All interments shall be in accordance with the Jewish Law (Halacha) as interpreted by the Chairman, Board of Directors of the Society. No burial may be made of the remains of a person who is not of the Jewish religion.

Restrictions on the erection and installation of headstones or markers exist in accordance with the by-laws of Chenstochover Aid Society.
