Information Provided to the Public

for Plot Reservation Purposes

The reservation of a plot constitutes the purchase of Interment Rights under The Cemeteries Act (Revised) and accordingly, the public is advised of the following:

- 1. The total price for reservation of a plot is the sum of \$_______, plus goods and services tax.
- 2. In addition to paying for Interment Rights, at the time of burial, the owner of the Interment Rights of his or her personal representative must pay the labour costs of opening and closing the grave. This amount is the fee established from time to time by the operator of the cemetery, Bathurst Lawn Cemetery Association.
- 3. In addition to the foregoing, when a headstone or marker is erected, there must be obtained from the Society a permit which is available on payment of the cost of the foundation on which the headstone or marker is erected currently \$300.00 for a single headstone and \$600.00 for a double headstone and otherwise without charge. There must also be paid the amount which is required from time to time to be paid into the Care and Maintenance fund as prescribed under The Cemeteries Act (Revised). This amount depends on the size of the headstone or marker. Current charges are: for an upright marker 4 feet or less in height and 4 feet or less in length including the base, the sum of \$100.00.
